- I. Create a sculpture of a character. Include a written character analysis.
- 2. Build a diorama representing an important scene from the book. Write the section from the book in quotes and include it in the diorama.
- 3. Write a character analysis describing your favorite character from the book. Include all the thoughts, opinions, likes, dislikes, etc. of the character.
- 4. Design a mini-book sequencing at least 6 main events of the book. A colorful illustration should represent each main event.
- 5. Write an advertisement to entice someone else to read your book. Include a catchy motto or "catch phrase" that captures the message or deep meaning from your book.
- 6. Write a friendship review. Would the main character be a good friend? Give at least 5 examples showing why or why not.
- 7. Write a friendly letter to a character in your book. Ask them questions about situations/problems from the book. Make complaints and/ or suggestions.
- 8. Make a colorful mobile that shows the characters, setting, symbols, etc.. Tell what you think about the book.
- 9. Write a magazine review of the book stating your opinions regarding the overall quality of the story, plot, characters, etc.. Think deeply and outside the box.
